

PMDC ANNOUNCES RESULT OF FOREIGN GRADUATE EXAMS

Islamabad 11th February 2016: The Pakistan Medical and Dental Council has announced the results of the National Examination Board examinations (NEB) step III OSCE / VIVA (Part 1) taken by Pakistani nationals with foreign basic medical and dental qualifications.

The exam was conducted by Shaheed Zulfiqar Ali Bhutto Medical University / PIMS Islamabad in Fatima Jinnah Medical University and Allama Iqbal Medical College, Lahore simultaneously.

In the NEB Step-III exam (OSCE / VIVA), **270** candidates appeared. Of them, **190** declared successful.

While talking to media the President PM&DC Prof.Dr.Shabir Lehri told that PM&DC new Council is aimed to eradicate corruption from the root of PM&DC therefore for the first time in history of PM&DC the British Council has also been involved in the NEB examining system to ensure utmost fairness and transparency in the examination. In Step-III examination, the total pass rate was **70%** percent. He added that PM&DC has also announced the step III examination result on the same day of the exam to avoid anxiety among the students and for saving their time too. Previously it used to take 2 weeks time to announce the result of the exam.
