

PM&DC ISSUES 7000 REGISTRATION CERTIFICATES

ISLAMABAD 26th February 2016: The Pakistan Medical and Dental Council (PM&DC) has issued 7000 registration renewal cases which were pending due to CME issues last year.

President PM&DC and Executive Committee members visited the registration section after being reported that almost 7000 cases were pending with the Council for renewal of registration certificates, they directed the staff to clear all the pending cases within 2 weeks time.

In a statement the President PM&DC Prof.Dr.Shabir Lehri said that due to these pending registration cases the doctors were facing a lot of difficulties and this act would help to allay the undue anxiety in the medical/dental community in the country. The staff of the registration section worked day and night to overcome the pending cases in a stipulated time.

He added the Council is also working on the agenda to introduce new mechanism to remove hurdles or any procedural delays in functioning of the organisation and handling of different type of cases.

PM&DC President Prof.Dr. Shabir Ahmad Lehri also said that the PM&DC Council is anxiously working on making the registration system handy and prompt for our doctors by converting it to online registering system. The fees and documents required for registration shall be sent online from any city of Pakistan in near future and working hard to set our standards at par with international standards.

Dr Bandesha who was personally supervising this matter said that it is all because of the commitment of the staff, leadership and vision of the PM&DC current administration that they took doctors' issues on priority basis. He said PMDC was going to settle the issue once for all by introducing an online registration system in order to prevent the doctors from such botheration.
