

**PM&DC PRESIDENT TAKES NOTICE AGAINST RAHBER MEDICAL
AND DENTAL COLLEGE, LAHORE**

Islamabad 12th February 2016: The President of Pakistan medical and Dental Council Prof.Dr.Shabir Lahri along with Executive Committee member Dr. Amir Hussain Bandeshah conducted a surprise visit to the Rahbar Medical and Dental College Lahore along with its affiliated hospital which is Rangers hospital. The said college was recognized in 2012 for training of 100 MBBS students. Currently third session of student is under training in the college.


While talking to the press, the PM&DC President told that the college is insufficient infrastructure including blank pathology lab. The dissection halls were empty; library had lacked relevant and updated books and study materials. Moreover the college had no auditorium for the students.

He told that the affiliated hospital of the said college i.e Ranger hospital had contained only 350 (three fifty) beds which had to be 500 (five hundred) bedded hospital for training of 100 medical students. He added that the teaching faculty of the said college was not available in the teaching hospital at the time of surprise visit.

Radiology department had insufficient teaching equipments and number of patients was not more than fifty in the whole hospital.CPC room was not even established in the said teaching hospital.

The President PM&DC showed serious concern that Rahbar Medical and Dental College is playing havoc with lives of people of Pakistan through producing untrained doctors.

The President PM&DC took serious notice of the Administration of Rahbar Medical and Dental College for having insufficient training facilities .In order to decide the registration and future of the college with PM&DC a team of inspectors will inspect Rahbar Medical and Dental college very soon.
