PMDC orders registration of postgraduate programmes

Pakistan Medical and Dental Council has asked doctors and dentists wanting to do post-graduation in their respective fields, to verify their courses' registration with it.

"We, PMDC, register only those post-graduation qualifications of accredited public and private universities and educational institutions, which are notified by the federal government and are included in the third schedule of PM&DC Act 2012. The details of degree awarding/training institutions, included in the said schedule, are available on our website for the benefit of everyone interested, especially intending students," Hina Shaukat, spokesperson for PMDC, told

'The News' on Monday.

The spokesperson said it was mandatory for all postgraduate medical and dental educational institutions to get themselves and their courses registered included in the third schedule of PMDC Act 2012 upon fulfilment of prerequisites set under the PMDC Ordinance 1962 and Postgraduate Regulations 2011.

She said registration with PMDC was mandatory for all postgraduates to get their degrees and diplomas mentioned on their registration certificates.

Hina Shaukat said PMDC had already directed all educational and training institutions to get their postgraduate programmes registered with it without delay for their inclusion in the third schedule of PMDC Act 2012.
