

LOW BED OCCUPANCY IS A BIG PROBLEM IN MEDICAL INSTITUTIONS: PRESIDENT PM&DC

28th February 2016: President PM&DC Prof.Dr.Shabir Lahri conducted a surprise visit to the Central park medical college to examine the facilities being provided to the students and standard of education. The president PM&DC visited all the departments of the college including hospital. The said college is recognized to train 100 MBBS students. Bhatti international teaching hospital and Wapda hospital are affiliated hospital with this college.

During the visit the President came to know that the college is having some issues with the Wapda hospital. Last year January Wapda hospital had informed the central park medical college about the cancellation of MOU but in last one year college admin never bothered to inform PM&DC that their 300 bedded Wapda teaching hospital is not available to the students for teaching. It is a gross negligence on part of the college administration college would have been derecognized as teaching students with out adequate clinical facilities and patients.

The president showed serious concern over this blunder by the college. He told the college administration to proceed for attachment of new hospital with the college. PM&DC will see whether rules and regulations allow such practice or not. If the college will fail to rectify this issue and other deficiencies the college will stand derecognized, said president PM&DC

President addressed the college faculty and told that medical education should not be used as a business. Every one who is related to the medical profession shall fulfill their responsibilities and duties according to PM&DC prescribed Code of ethics in order to give justice to their noble profession.
