


PMDC has directed the Management of all Private Medical and Dental Colleges not to charge extra fee from their MBBS and BDS students.

Islamabad: 20th December 2017: Pakistan Medical and Dental council has directed to all the managements of all private medical and dental colleges not to take any extra fee in the name of donation and any other monetary.

According to the PM&DC rules and regulations the medical and dental institution training for MBBS / BDS in the private sector shall charge tuition fee more than six lacs forty two thousand only Rs.6,42,000/- per annum per student excluding university examination fee, taxes, hostel fee, transport fee and one time admission fee, which shall not be more than Rs.50,000/- only. Copies of all receipts shall be submitted to the PM&DC. The fee for foreign admission in private or public colleges can be in foreign currency and shall not exceed more than eighteen thousand dollars per annum all inclusive, and not even one dollar over this shall be charged on any pretext. All the private medical and dental institution shall maintain a separate online account in a scheduled bank and all fees and charges to be received from students shall be deposited by students or parents guardians in the online account and no cash shall be demanded from students for any fee and charges. This account number must be mentioned in prospectus and website with fee and charges structure.

Any other monetary demand or any other charge / donation on any pretext other than the annual fee as laid down in these regulations or any other non compliance of these regulations if reported shall be construed a major violation and make the institution liable for action under section 22 of the PM&DC ordinance 1962.
