

**COUNTRY WISE DETAIL OF FOREIGN GRADUATES  
APPEARED IN NEB EXAM AND THEIR PERCENTAGE**

**Islamabad 3<sup>rd</sup> March 2016:** Seventy-six per cent candidates have passed the Pakistan Medical and Dental Council National Examination Board (NEB) Step III OSCE/Viva held on 11,12,13<sup>th</sup> February 2016 .

A total of 681 candidates, who did graduation in medicine from abroad, sat in the exam and 522 of them turned out to be successful, according to the PM&DC.

**A per details issued by the PM&DC 07 candidates appeared from Afghanistan 04 passed the exam with 57.14 %, 02 candidates appeared from Azerbaijan 02 passed the exam with 100 %, 02 candidates appeared from Belarus 02 passed the exam with 100 %, 06 candidates appeared from Bangladesh 06 passed the exam with 100 %, 417 candidates appeared from China 310 passed the exam with 74.34 %, 02 candidates appeared from Georgia 02 passed the exam with 100 %, 24 candidates appeared from Kazakhstan 15 passed the exam with 62.5 %, 131 candidates appeared from Kyrgyz Republic 104 passed the exam with 79.38 %, 01 candidates appeared from Lithuania 01 passed the exam with 100 %, 01 candidates appeared from Philippines 01 passed the exam with 100 %, 54 candidates appeared from Republic of Cuba 52 passed the exam with 96.29 %, 14 candidates appeared from Russia 12 passed the exam with 85.71 %, 17 candidates appeared from Ukraine 12 passed the exam with 70.58 %, 01 candidates appeared from Dominican Republic and 02 candidates appeared from Tajikistan no candidate passed the exam and the percentage was 0%.**

The examination took place at Lahore. The overall pass rate of Part I exam was 70 per cent, that of Part II exam 77 per cent and that of Part III exam 86 per cent.
