

PM&DC ESTABLISHES COMPLAINT CELL FOR COLLEGES WHO ARE CHARGING MORE THAN THE PRESCRIBED FEE

Islamabad 7th November 2016: The Pakistan Medical and Dental Council has set up a complaint cell for all the students seeking admission in the medical and dental colleges for the year 2016-2017.

According to PMDC Acting Registrar Dr.Syed Azhr Ali Shah, the purpose of establishing the cell is to address complaints of students who intend to seek admission in both Public and Private medical and dental colleges. He told reporters that according to the new medical and dental admission policy the private medical and dental colleges are bound to charge prescribe tuition fee which PM&DC has finalised in titled "MBBS and BDS Admissions, House job and Internship Regulations, 2016" that is 642000/- which includes Annual tuition fee per student excluding university examination fee, taxes, hostel fee and transport.

The PMDC Registrar said that a complaint cell has been established in response to regulation of medical and dental admission policy 2016 to take prompt action on such complaints.

President PM&DC Prof.Dr.Shabir Lehri, while contacted said that the medical and dental admission policy has been made to facilitate the public of Pakistan so that their children could get a better opportunity of admission on merit in the medical and dental colleges. PMDC had received several complaints over the years of private medical and dental colleges are minting money from the students in different heads therefore PM&DC has Gazzet notified a fix amount for admission fee and if any private medical and dental college charges more money than the prescribed fee schedule, students and parents are informed to file/lodge complaints at the PM&DC complaint cell through email i.e president complaint cell or visit PM&DC.
