

PM&DC CONSTITUTES NEW COMMITTEE TO MONITOR NEB EXAMINATION FOR FOREIGN GRADUATES

Islamabad 22th January 2016: The Newly elected President of Pakistan Medical and Dental Council constituted a committee to monitor and look after the conduct of National Examination Board (NEB). The forthcoming step III exam is scheduled to be held on 11, 12,13th February 2016 under collaboration with of University of Health Sciences, Lahore (UHS).

While talking to the press Prof.Dr Shabeer Lehri (President of PM&DC) said that there is a dire need to improve the working of PM&DC and there will be zero tolerance for corruption in the organization and the affairs of the PM&DC will be streamlined on merit and transparency at every level.

He further told that PM&DC NEB examination is a very important part of PM&DC and in order to improve the system. A committee has been constituted to monitor the NEB exam. The Committee is comprised of very professional members which includes Prof.Dr.Mehmood Shaukat (Principal, Allama Iqbal Medical College Lahore), Prof.Dr.Sardar Fakhar Imam (Vice Chancellor Fatima Jinnah Medical University Lahore) and Prof.Dr.Kamran Salick (Principal Nistar Medical College Multan).

He told that the Committee shall supervise and make liaison with the concerned university regarding conduct of the examination in transparent manner. The committee shall ensure that the format of NEB Examination step III must be patient based clinical oriented so that the assessment and the clinical competency / knowledge of the candidates can be judged in a better way. The Committee will also ensure transparent compilation of the results and will arrange the lists of credible examiners in all the relevant subjects for the examination.

President PM&DC also told that he had visited every section of PM&DC along with Dr Amir Hussain Bendeshah member Executive Committee to check the problems and issues being faced by the doctors and staff.

He emphasized that no nepotism or grouping will be tolerated in the office. He said that all the staff should put in their best efforts to uplift the image of the PM&DC. He added that office of the president will remain open to all the employees and doctors are always welcome to discuss their problems

He also pledged to make PM&DC a very vibrant, effective and user-friendly institution for the medical and dental practitioners of the country. He added that he will be easily available to address the grievances of doctors.

He also met with the doctors in the reception area to know the problems faced by them while submission of their documents. He asked suggestions from the doctors for improving the system of registration.
