**Ex-PMDC  
registrar's name  
put on ECL**

The National Accountability Bureau (NAB) is tightening noose around former Pakistan Medical and Dental Council registrar Dr. Ahmad Nadeem Akbar, over the alleged administrative and financial irregularities at the PMDC.

It first issued warrants for his arrest and has now stopped him from going overseas by getting his name placed on Exit Control List (ECL) and his assets frozen.

According to a NAB official, the action has been initiated on the reports of 'massive corruption, misuse of authority, violation of rules and procedures, and accumulation of assets beyond known sources of income under the NAB Prevention Regime Initiatives.'

He said that Dr. Nadeem Akbar's assets included two houses in F-11/1 and one plot in G-10, Islamabad, accounts in United Bank Limited, Askari Bank and National Bank of Pakistan, foreign accounts in the US and UAE, a Corolla car, and accounts of two wives in Askari Bank.
