

5% Medical and Dental Students will be sent for free education in Kyrgyzstan

Islamabad 1st March 2016: Kyrgyzstan met PM&DC President Professor Dr. Shabbir Lehri at PM&DC office Islamabad on 1st March to discuss issues related to medical /dental education provided in the Kyrgyzstan. The delegation was headed by the Ambassador Mr. Ishadbaik Ambassador.

They discussed and deliberated on improving the standards of the medical education standards. The ambassador ensured that the standard and criteria of medical education shall be comparable with the Pakistani medical education system.
