

PM&DC HOLDS FOREIGN GRADUATES ELIGIBILITY EXAMINATION

ISLAMABAD 18TH September 2015: The Pakistan Medical and Dental Council (PM&DC) is conducting the registration examination of Pakistanis who graduated from foreign medical/dental colleges on 19th September 2015, Saturday at Comsats, Islamabad. Approximately 3000 candidates are appearing in the examination.

The Management Committee while talking to the media emphasized that they are trying to hold a transparent examination for the foreign graduates and ensuring that there should not be any security breach during the examination.

The Committee said that this is a record number of medical and dental graduates who are appearing in the National Examination Board (NEB) since it started in 1992. All the candidates have acquired their basic qualification from abroad from foreign medical and dental colleges/universities like China, Russia, Bangladesh, Philippine and Iran etc.

They apprised that the current examination is being conducted under the supervision of National Examination Board of PM&DC with the help of University of Health Sciences, Lahore which provided the academic support.

The Chairman Management Committee Maj. Gen. (R) Dr. Azhar Mehmood Kayani said that all the concerned Medical/Dental foreign students are welcome to raise their queries. He further emphasized that if any employee of PM&DC or outsider asks for any bribe /monetary benefit from the student, they can file their complaints any time to the Management Committee.

He said, the purpose of this examination is to evaluate the competency and clinical skills of the graduates in order to issue them the license to practice and register their foreign qualifications as required under the law.
